Visegrad 4 Eastern Partnership Program

Visegrad 4 Eastern Partnership Program (V4EaP) was initiated in 2011 by the governments of the Visegrad Group countries (see [Joint Statement...](#) from June 2011) to enhance the cooperation between the Visegrad region and the countries of the Eastern Partnership (EaP)—Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Moldova and Ukraine. The main aims are facilitating the unique know-how of the Visegrad countries with social and economic transformation, democratization and regional cooperation particularly through the development of civil society and support of cooperation among local governments, universities and individual citizens.


The program was launched in early 2012 with total budget of €1,456,800 under four separate grant and mobility programs. Including a grant from the [Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Netherlands](#) in the amount of €1.5 million awarded to the program in June 2012, V4EaP is currently the Fund's biggest grant program.

Flagship Projects



Program designed for long-term project of strategic character that link grantees in the Visegrad region with those in the EaP countries. There are no set deadlines; instead projects are solicited on the basis of concrete calls for proposals. [See more...](#)

Visegrad University Studies Grants—EaP

The EaP variant of the “classic” [VUSG](#) program is specifically targeting colleges and universities in the EaP region. The grant is intended as a support for the development, accreditation and launching of university courses or whole degree programs that deal with specific phenomena related to the V4 countries experience with transformation, democratization, human rights, EU accession, etc. Average support is €10,000 per course and €40,000 per degree program.
