Visegrad University Studies Grants—EaP

The Visegrad University Studies Grants (VUSG) program targeting the countries of the Eastern Partnership (EaP) expands the current VUSG program and offers grant funding to projects developing university courses of degree programs that will be launched at colleges and universities accredited in the EaP countries. The program enables these colleges, universities or their legal units (schools, faculties) to apply with proposals for courses or programs of various academic fields that focus on sharing specific V4 experience with democratization and transformation process, regional cooperation, the EU accession process, etc.

Any public or private university in the EaP countries is eligible for the grant. The course/program can be taught in any language. The course/program is expected to secure for each semester of its enrollment at least two/three relevant guest lecturers from two V4 countries (others than that of the applicant).

Deadline: November 10, 2014, 11:59 a.m. CET

Annual budget: €80,000

The project application must be filled out in English and should include the following attachments:

- 1. Professional CV(s) of the coordinator(s)
- 2. Course syllabus/program curriculum
- 3. Tentative letters of agreement from the guest lecturers
- 4. Confirmation about the enrollment of the course within given program (continuation)
- 5. Copy of ministerial accreditation (where applicable)
- 6. Copy of identification documents of the applicant institution
- 7. Course description(s) for each course within a degree program
